

**AMENDMENT**

**OFFERED BY MR. JORDAN OF OHIO**

Add at the end of the bill the following:

1       TITLE \_\_\_\_—APPROPRIATIONS AT LOWER  
2               PREVIOUS FISCAL YEAR LEVELS

3       That the following sums are hereby appropriated, out  
4 of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,  
5 and out of applicable corporate or other revenues, receipts,  
6 and funds, for the several departments, agencies, corpora-  
7 tions, and other organizational units of Government for  
8 fiscal year 2011, and for other purposes, namely:

9       SEC. \_\_\_\_\_. (a) The amounts provided in the appro-  
10 priations Acts for fiscal year 2008 referred to in section  
11 101 of division A of Public Law 110-329 and under the  
12 authority and conditions provided in such Acts for projects  
13 or activities (including the costs of direct loans and loan  
14 guarantees) that are not otherwise provided for, that were  
15 conducted in fiscal years 2008 and 2010, and for which  
16 appropriations, funds, or other authority were made avail-  
17 able in such Acts.

18       (b) If the amount provided for a project or activity  
19 by subsection (a) would be higher than the amount pro-  
20 vided in appropriation Acts for fiscal year 2010, such

1 project or activity shall be funded at the lower such  
2 amount.

3 SEC. \_\_\_\_\_. There is hereby enacted into law the pro-  
4 visions of the following:

5 (1) The Department of Defense Appropriations  
6 Act, 2011, as reported in the 111th Congress by the  
7 Subcommittee on Defense of the Committee on Ap-  
8 propriations of the House of Representatives.

9 (2) The Department of Homeland Security Ap-  
10 propriations Act, 2011, as reported in the 111th  
11 Congress by the Subcommittee on Homeland Secu-  
12 rity of the Committee on Appropriations of the  
13 House of Representatives.

14 (3) The Military Construction and Veterans Af-  
15 fairs and Related Agencies Appropriations Act,  
16 2011, as passed in the 111th Congress by the House  
17 of Representatives.

18 SEC. \_\_\_\_\_. Appropriations made by section \_\_\_\_  
19 shall be available to the extent and in the manner that  
20 would be provided by the pertinent appropriations Act.

21 SEC. \_\_\_\_\_. Unless otherwise provided for in the appli-  
22 cable appropriations Act, appropriations and funds made  
23 available and authority granted pursuant to this joint res-  
24 olution shall be available through September 30, 2011.

1       SEC. \_\_\_\_\_. For entitlements and other mandatory  
2 payments whose budget authority was provided in appro-  
3 priations Acts for fiscal year 2010, and for activities under  
4 the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008, activities shall be  
5 continued at the rate to maintain program levels under  
6 current law, under the authority and conditions provided  
7 in the applicable appropriations Act for fiscal year 2010,  
8 to be continued through the date specified in section 104.

9       SEC. \_\_\_\_\_. Funds appropriated by this joint resolu-  
10 tion may be obligated and expended notwithstanding sec-  
11 tion 10 of Public Law 91-672 (22 U.S.C. 2412), section  
12 15 of the State Department Basic Authorities Act of 1956  
13 (22 U.S.C. 2680), section 313 of the Foreign Relations  
14 Authorization Act, Fiscal Years 1994 and 1995 (22  
15 U.S.C. 6212), and section 504(a)(1) of the National Secu-  
16 rity Act of 1947 (50 U.S.C. 414(a)(1)).

17       SEC. \_\_\_\_\_. None of the funds made available in this  
18 joint resolution may be used to carry out any program  
19 under, promulgate any regulation pursuant to, or defend  
20 against any lawsuit challenging any provision of, Public  
21 Law 111-148 or Public Law 111-152 or any amendment  
22 made by either such Public Law.

23       SEC. \_\_\_\_\_. None of the funds made available in this  
24 joint resolution may be used for a congressional earmark

1 as defined in clause 9(e) of rule XXI of the Rules of the  
2 House of Representatives.

Further, add at the end of the bill the following:

3 **TITLE \_\_\_\_\_—ARRA RESCISSION**  
4 **AND REPEALS**

5 **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . ARRA RESCISSION AND REPEALS.**

6 (a) RESCISSION.—Of the discretionary appropria-  
7 tions made available in division A of the American Recov-  
8 ery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Public Law 111-5),  
9 all unobligated balances are rescinded.

10 (b) REPEALS.—Subtitles B and C of title II and titles  
11 III through VII of division B of the American Recovery  
12 and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Public Law 111-5) are  
13 repealed.
